Richardson TSI Gives \$12,000 In-Kind Donation To Help Abused and Neglected Children in Hall and Dawson Counties

SUWANEE, Ga. (July 28, 2009)— To provide such a refuge for child abuse victims, Richardson Technology Systems Inc. (TSI) made an in-kind donation worth \$12,000 to assist the Hall-Dawson Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) program and the Edmondson Telford Center for Children in the construction of a new state-of-the-art facility to centralize and increase resources for abused or neglected children.

“With a reported 14,000 abused or neglected children in Georgia, providing a safe environment for crisis intervention as well as medical and legal advocacy is imperative,” says Richardson TSI President Joseph Ciotti. “Richardson TSI is dedicated to giving back to the community it serves. We are more than happy to help organizations, which dedicate their time and services to ensuring the safety and well-being of abused or neglected children, like Hall-Dawson CASA and the Edmondson Telford Center for Children.”

The \$12,000 in-kind donation by Richardson TSI included: a security and fire system, a closed circuit television system for video monitoring and recording to enable forensic exams, as well as an access control system to prevent unauthorized entry into both wings of the building. The donation also provided a fire and burglary panel, GE high resolution weatherproof cameras, widescreen LCD monitors, digital video recorders and electronic door strikes.

Little House, the new home to both the Hall-Dawson CASA program and the Edmondson Telford Center for Children, will have its grand opening on August 7 from 2 p.m. through 6 p.m. The new 10,000 square foot building, located at 603 Washington St., in Gainesville, Ga., will offer onsite medical exams, forensic interviewing services, as well as support from trained volunteers to advocate for the best interests of children requiring court intervention.
